We then participated in traditional rhythm, song and dance games and heard Dreaming Stories passed down from Aboriginal Elders. We learned some Bundjalung language for greetings, animals and numbers before going for a walk to look and listen for whales and birds. We then learned about weapons and animal skins and how they were used in day to day life of Bundjalung people. The children thoroughly enjoyed their day of learning and adventure.



Last week we were excited to have 5 of our 2025 Kindergarten students and their parents attend an orientation morning. The Pebbles class made the preschoolers feel welcome and new and old friendships were forged. Thank you to Zoe, Mirani and Toni for welcoming our new families.
